Giving recommendations to journalists...



- 1 Take the opportunity to educate the public about
- 2 Avoid language which sensationalizes or normalizes suicide, or presents it as a solution to problems
- 3 Avoid prominent placement and undue repetition of stories about suicide
- 4 Avoid explicit description of the method used in a completed or attempted suicide
- Avoid providing detailed information about the site of a completed or attempted suicide
- 6 Word headlines carefully
- 7 Exercise caution in using photographs or video
- 8 Take particular care in reporting celebrity suicides
- 9 Show due consideration for people bereaved by
- 10 Provide information about where to seek help
- 11 Recognize that media professionals themselves may be affected by stories about suicide







...ls not enough!

- Journalist most often ignore both their responsibility and the existence of the recommendations (Jamieson, 2003; Colling & Kemp, 2010)
- Recommendations need to part and parcel of specific prevention campaigns to be applied (Tatum, 2010; Fu, 2011; Bohanna & Wang, 2012; Chandra, 2013; Michel, 2000; Pirkis, 2009)

CHANGE STRATEGY!

- Bring resources rather than prescribing
- Collaboration rather than service provision
- Sensitization


